

The Witch Hunt.

The *Catholic Exchange*, a small but vocal website who aims to promote Roman Catholic Values also seeks to prevent "Transgender" and "Gender confused" people from getting any legal protection under the law in most countries.

The question is why? Well, I have a simple answer to this, and the two partners in crime at the Catholic Exchange are not going to like it. Dale O Leary and Mary Kochan make a number of comments and statements that really need to be interpreted at face value.
